Job Summary:

Scope and Responsibilities:

This position is responsible for the cleanliness of the facility. This position will include working with cleaning chemicals and equipment.

- Cleaning of restrooms, locker rooms, and showers
- Sweeping, vacuuming, mopping
- Removal of trash
- Cleaning of equipment
- Sanitization of high-touch surfaces
- Filling soap/paper towel/toilet paper dispensers
- Various other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Candidates should be at least 18 years old.
- Cleaning experience welcomed but not necessary
- Report any items that may provide a health or safety hazard to staff, members or guests to the maintenance staff.
- Must be able to work some evenings and weekends.

Requirements & Physical Demands:

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is often required to: climb stairs, bend, stoop, kneel, twist, reach with hands, sit, stand for an extended period of time, climb ladders, walk, paint, lift and/or move up to 40 pounds, have finger dexterity, grasp, perform repetitive motions, communicate and have visual acuity.
