- Ensures safety by communicating and enforcing pool rules, policies, and guidelines
- Trains participants in a manner that is both demonstrative and professional
- Set up and tear down of utilized equipment
- Begins and ends every session on time
- Takes attendance of class each time class is held
- Provides excellent member service
- Promotes aquatics and other YMCA programs
- Communicates any concerns or incidents to supervisor
- Communicates any suggestions to improve the aquatics facility
- Knows and administers the appropriate EAP (emergency action plan) for any situation
- Completes incident and accident reports as required
- Knows the names of members and uses their names when speaking with them
- Responsible to assist in the cleanliness of the pool and reporting any maintenance needs
