The YMCA Child Development Center is seeking candidates to fill teacher and assistant teacher positions.

Qualified candidates should be able to provide a quality experience to children and parents that focuses on the YMCA values of honesty, respect, responsibility, and caring.

Candidate must have the ability to demonstrate and/or show competency in the following areas:

- Supervising youth and presenting positive role modeling through all interactions with program participants.
- To meet program goals as outlined in the YMCA Childcare Policies and Procedures Manual.
- To keep confidences, loyalties and practice professionalism.
- Be reliable and dependable.
- Work a flexible schedule to meet program staffing/planning needs.
- Exercise mature judgment and sound decision making.
- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- Conduct the highest level of attention, care and adherence to regulations and operational instructions for meals and feedings, diaper changing, potty training, restroom and personal hygiene assistance.
- Assists in implementing daily activities that promote the healthy emotional, social, cognitive, physical, and spiritual growth of each child.
- Helps maintain accurate and complete records for each child's development, which can be reported to parents as needed.
- Be aware of children with special needs and accommodate as needed and as able.
- With Director of Child Development, ensures compliance with all licensing requirements and maintaining required program records.
- Communicates effectively with parents about their children on a daily basis.
- Helps maintain an attractive, safe and healthy environment, including creating room decorations, completing daily cleaning duties, and other miscellaneous tasks.
- Assists in performing daily activities; including, setting up the classroom, conducting activities, monitoring playground activities, cleaning and sanitizing toys and equipment.

- Performs any and all other duties that are required or that may be assigned to achieve the mission and goals of the YMCA.

Experience/Certification Required:

Must be at least 18 years of age.

High School diploma or higher degree in early childhood education required.

Experience with children in a developmental setting preferred.

Salary/Benefits:

Pay rate is competitive and commensurate with experience.
